Conferred by Madam Fadilah Baharin, Director General of Department of Standards Malaysia (Standards Malaysia) to CP Dato's Seri Mohamad Fuzi bin Harun, Pengarah Pasukan Petugas Khas (Operasi/Counter Terrorism), the forensic lab is now accredited under Skim Akreditasi Makmal Malaysia (SAMM); and the certification is valid for a period of three years from the issue date of 7 March 2013.
