TRANSITION TO PEFC ST 2002:2020, PEFC ST 2003:2020 AND PEFC PRODUCT CATEGORIES

A. Introduction and scope

The following documents were recently published by the PEFC International

This circular is to inform the Department of Standards Malaysia (JSM)'s applicant/accredited CBs on the requirements for the transition to the above documents.

B. Requirements

1. Accredited Certification Bodies

- By 14 August 2022, it is mandatory for all the Certification Bodies and their certified clients to transition to new PEFC ST standards and documents listed in the table in A. above.
- ii. For CBs that <u>have not yet</u> to transition to PEFC ST 2002:2020 and PEFC Product Categories:
 - a) The CB will be assessed during the scheduled office assessment.
 - b) If there is **no scheduled assessment** planned this year, the CB shall arrange with JSM to conduct a verification assessment.
- iii. CB's that <u>have</u> transitioned to PEFC ST 2002:2020 but have not yet been assessed for the PEFC Product Categories, the CB shall arrange with JSM to conduct a verification assessment.
- iv. Prior to assessment for the PEFC Product Categories, Certification Bodies (CBs) are requested to submit the following:
 - a) Gap analysis of the previous version with the current version;
 - Revised list of PEFC Product Categories as determined by the Malaysian Timber Certification Council (MTCC);
 - c) Auditor training records/documents; and
 - d) Review of auditor competence based on the PEFC Product Categories.
- v. For transition to accredited certification based on PEFC ST 2003:2020,
 - a) the CB shall arrange a witnessing assessment based on the new standard with JSM before the transition date;
 - b) the CB shall update JSM on 1 September 2022 on the status of certified clients.
- vi. Upon successful transition, JSM will issue the CB's scope of accreditation based on PEFC ST 2002:2020, accreditation for certification based on PEFC ST 2003: 2020 and update the scope based on PEFC Product Categories.

3.1 New Application:

i. All new applications received after <u>1 January 2022</u> shall be based on PEFC ST 2002:2020 and PEFC Product Categories.

C. Validity of PEFC ST 2003:2012 and PEFC ST 2002:2013

By **14**th **August 2022**, any CBs that have yet to transition to PEFC ST 2002:2020, certification based on PEFC ST 2003:2020 and PEFC Product Categories will have their accreditation suspended for 3 months. If no action is taken within that period, accreditation will be withdrawn.
