The Scheme for the Accreditation of Certification Bodies (The ACB Scheme) ACB CIRCULAR 6/2017

TRANSITION OF STANDARDS MALAYSIA CRITERIA DOCUMENT: ACB-MALAYSIAN SUSTAINABLE PALM OIL (ACB-MSPO) TO ACB-OIL PALM MANAGEMENT CERTIFICATION (ACB-OPMC)

1. Background

Due to request from the Malaysian Palm Oil Certification Council (MPOCC), the scheme owner for Malaysian Sustainable Palm Oil (MSPO), the Department of Standards Malaysia (Standards Malaysia) has revised ACB-MSPO document to strengthen the accreditation criteria on the oil palm management system.

Four (4) series document were established and approved on 1 August 2017 as per below:

- ACB-OPMC 1: Competency Requirements for Certification Bodies Operating Oil Palm Management Certification Under The Malaysian Sustainable Palm Oil (MSPO) Certification Scheme
- ii) ACB-OPMC 2: Audit Duration for Certification Bodies Operating Oil Palm Management Certification Under The Malaysian Sustainable Palm Oil (MSPO) Certification Scheme
- iii) ACB-OPMC 3: Peer Review Process Requirements for Certification Bodies Operating Oil Palm Management Certification Under The Malaysian Sustainable Palm Oil (MSPO) Certification Scheme
- iv) ACB-OPMC 4: Stakeholder Consultation Requirements for Certification Bodies Operating Oil Palm Management Certification Under The Malaysian Sustainable Palm Oil (MSPO) Certification Scheme

The ACB-OPMC series of documents cancels and replaces the ACB-MSPO document (Issue 1, 8 December 2015)

2. Standards Malaysia requirements for the transition to ACB-OPMC

2.1 Accredited Certification Bodies:

The transition period for these documents will be for 6 months beginning 1 August 2017. Any findings based on these documents will be raised as observation during the transition period. Starting 1 February 2018, all findings will be raised as non-conformance.

2.2 New applicant and Extension of Scope

For new applications or extension of scope received by Standards Malaysia from Certification Bodies (CBs) for accreditation, the four new ACB-OPMC documents, dated 1 August 2017, will immediately apply.
